

The format of the speaking test is explained to the candidates before they enter the exam room in their native language, usually by a person they know, or by their teacher. This person takes the candidates into the exam room and introduces them to the examiner. The section is assessed based on a rating for vocabulary and grammar, pronunciation and interaction.
